



Welcome aboard the *Anija*

COSTS RELATED TO YOUR CRUISE AND
CONDITIONS FOR AN EXCELLENT STAY ON
BOARD WITH US **VOILEAVENTURECULTURE**

Traveling alone or in a group, with or without sailing experience, these cabin cruises are for you.

1. Itinerary and weather

Overall, the planned route will be respected, but for reasons of *force majeure* and/or weather the planned route may vary. * **In case of immobilization of the boat for meteorological reasons or force majeure no refunds will be offered.**

In these cases, the captain will work with the participant (crew) to find replacement activities ashore. In all cases the captains' priority will be first and foremost the safety of the passengers and secondarily the sailboat. The *Anija* is a sailboat of 15m which is built for the ocean, perfectly adapted to navigate in these waters.

2. Physical and medical conditions

Each participant of the cruise must be able to sail and have the physical and mental fitness to do so. Any medical conditions or concerns must be reported to the captain at the time of booking, if these medical conditions could cause risks to the participant or to other team members. Participants taking medication or who may be in a situation requiring specific care should report it to the captain immediately. Medical services in the Greek Islands are accessible should they be required.

3. Major damage

In the event of damage requiring the immobilization of the boat, and which is not caused by the participants, the captain will grant the refund, or the replacement of the days lost, not including the first 24 hours of immobilization; This clause does not cover damage to auxiliary machinery other than propulsion machinery.

4. Claim

Should you encounter an issue on the cruise you must immediately inform the captain of your complaint or claim.

5. Insurance

The boat and the crew are insured in case of accidents and serious damage. It is essential that each participant obtains their **own personal travel insurance** with her/his insurer before departure.

6. The captain

The captain is bilingual (French/English), knowledgeable of the navigation area, and excited to get you involved in the sailing maneuvers should you desire it. At the island stopovers, the captain will indicate the possible sites of interest and will make necessary effort to facilitate your discovery of the Greek islands and the Turkish coast. The captain will provide guidance and facilitate as he is able, however the captain is not responsible for your island visits. The captain does not function as a tourist guide on the ground it is the participants responsibility to find and coordinate their island activities.

7. Families and children

Families with young children are welcome on board, however while onboard young children are to wear life jackets at all times. In general, young people under the age of 17 must be accompanied by an adult.

9. Price of a cruise

Minimum duration of cruise is 7 days or more.

Departure of the cruise require a minimum of 4 people

Rates per week (7 days) or by day in Canadian, Euro and US currency:

- Adults: Canadian currency 980.00\$/week/person, 140.00\$/day/person
- Euro currency 780 E/week/person, 115 E/day/person
- Currency, US
900,00\$/week/person, 130.00\$/day/person
- Children 7 to 12 years of age: Canadian
800,00\$/week, 115.00\$/day/person or 630
Euros/week, 90 Euros/day/person or 750.00\$
US, 110/day/person
- Children under 7 are free if they share their
parents' cabin.

These prices include:

- Accommodation on the sailboat include 4 cabins (3 double cabins with air conditioning to share, a cabin for the captain). This sail boat can sleep 11 people.
- The captain's services,
- Bedding (bed linen),
- Gas for cooking (4 canisters of butane = 10 kilos)
- Complete cleaning service of the sailboat: inside, outside and hull.
- Safety equipment for all (self inflating life jacket, life raft)

For the rest of the expenses, it is suggested that a shared fund or petty cash is set up by the participants (suggestion: 100 euros / week per participant). The petty cash (owned and managed by the passenger) which care of the food and meals eaten on board, the captain's meals, the port costs (which are usually 15 to 20 euros / day), marina fees (40 to 50 euros / day), water and electricity (if needed this is approximately 10 to 20 euros), fuel oil (Volvo 75 hp fuel consumption 6.5l per hour. * *These estimates are subject to change depending on the economic context of the country.*

Not included in the petty cash are off-board alcohol consumption (bar or other), restaurant meals (3 to 12 Euros), travels on the island, hiring of vehicles (car 35 Euro, taxi, scooter 8 to 15 Euro etc.), which will be an additional personal expense. An expense log tracking the petty cash is kept up-to-date by the participants and can be consulted at any time. The shared funds in the petty cash will be paid for and managed by the cruise participants.

10. Reservation and method of payment

Your reservation must be made in writing and returned to us by email with a **deposit of a 30% (non-refundable)** of the total amount of the invoice payable to the name of Yvon Néolet by bank draft, transfer Interac to (yvon@voileaventureculture.com) by bank transfer and / or by credit card with PayPal (added 3% fee if you pay by PayPal) by going on the website of: **www.voileaventureculture.com**.

This deposit confirms your booking and the acceptance of your selected cruise dates. The payment of the 30% deposit implies that the participants have understood and accept all the terms and conditions of the cruise. The balance of the costs of the non-refundable cruise is payable in the name of Yvon Néolet in full 30 days before your boarding either by bank draft, transfer Interac, by bank transfer

and / or by credit card with PayPal on the site of:

Your participation in a cruise and reservation of the agreed upon dates will be confirmed by email upon receipt of the 30% deposit.

11. Document required for your stay

All Canadian or American participants in the cruise must have a valid passport. A visa is required to visit Turkey. The Turkish visa can be obtained online at a cost of US \$ 60.00, the website to purchase your visa is **www.evisa@gouv.ta** (visa fees subject to change please check the website). For all other participants of the European Union, it is your duty to have the proper entry documents in these regions. **Travel insurance is strongly recommended for your peace of mind.**

12. Guaranteed departure

Departures are guaranteed with a minimum of 4 participants per cruise. Participants are encouraged to find 4 family members/friends to meet this minimum number of people. If the number of participants is not met travelers have the option to pay the fees of 4 participants or we reserve the right to join other participants to complete the group. The captain reserves the right to decide in certain situations that departures are feasible without the minimum number of 4 participants.

13. Cancellation condition

We may have to cancel the cruise less than 21 days before the departure date for security reasons, social events, strikes, natural disasters. In this case, we will refund all costs already paid for the cruise to each participant (renting of cabin). We will not be responsible for additional expenses incurred by the participant (i.e. flights, hotels etc.). Travel insurance is recommended.
